Maidenhead LTC Open Veterans' Tournament 2010 (BER301)

Conditions of Entry

1. The tournament is sanctioned by the Lawn Tennis Association (BER301) as an LTA Grade 4 Rankings Tournament and will be run in strict accordance with the ITF Rules of Tennis, the Rules of the LTA and the LTA Tournament Regulations, including the LTA Code of Conduct (which may be amended from time to time).
2. Further information about this tournament including a full tournament prospectus is available from the clubs website (www.mltd.co.uk).
3. Only those competitors who have reached the minimum age for the event they have entered on or before 31st December 2010 shall be eligible to compete.
4. Every competitor must be a British Tennis member and have a rating. Players who do not have a British Tennis Membership number or LTA rating can apply online at www.lta.org.uk or by calling 020 8487 7000.
5. Entries will close on Friday 10th September 2010 at 12.00 noon and must be accompanied by the correct entry fee.
6. Any competitor wishing to withdraw may do so up to 13th September 2010 by 9.00am without forfeiting their entry fee after this deadline players withdrawing whatever the reason shall forfeit their entry fee.
7. The draw for all events will take place at Maidenhead LTC on Thursday 16th September 2010 at 7.30pm. The Committee will seed all events in accordance with LTA Regulations.
8. No competitor may enter more than ONE singles and ONE doubles event.
9. The tournament referee is Chris Mann. Contact Number 07872 639567 (prior to & during the event). Chris is an LTA Accredited Referee and a member of the Association of British Tennis Officials.
10. Competitors must be available to play from 10.00am daily unless the Referee tells them otherwise and must report directly to the Referee immediately on arrival.
11. Limited car parking is available at the club. The club accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage however caused. Overflow parking is available in All Saints Avenue and competitors are asked to park with consideration to our local residents.
12. In the case of adverse weather the Referee may use hard courts in the local area and may modify or curtail the tournament if he sees fit. Competitors may be required to play under floodlights. The court surfaces are porous acrylic and macadam.
13. Competitors must wear recognised tennis clothing. Only tennis shoes are permitted. Trainers or any shoes the Referee considers may damage the courts are not permitted.
14. The tournament committee reserve the right to decline any entry.
15. The decision of the referee and/or tournament committee is on all matters relating to the tournament shall be final.
16. No complaint relating to the Tournament will be considered unless lodged in writing with the Tournament Committee within 48 hours of the cause of the complaint. The decision of the Committee in all matters shall be final.
17. Entry constitutes acceptance of the Tournament rules including:
 - i. **Doping Statement:** "I consent to participating in doping control procedures if selected, undertaken by a doping control officer appointed by UK Sport."
 - ii. **Disciplinary Statement:** "I acknowledge and agree that I am subject to the Rules and Regulations of the LTA (including, without limitation, the LTA's Tournament Regulations, Anti-Doping Programme, Disciplinary and Dispute Resolution Procedures and the Regulations Concerning Match Fixing, Financial Speculation and Betting) and hereby fully and unconditionally submit to the jurisdiction and authority of the LTA."
 - iii. **Media Statement:** "I consent to being involved in any publicity connected with LTA Staged or Supported Tournaments, including media interviews, photographs, TV footage and LTA research projects. Please inform the tournament organiser if you do not wish to be involved in such publicity."
 - iv. **British Tennis Membership:** "I consent to the details provided on this entry form to be used to update the membership record of the person identified."
 - v. **Data Usage Statement:** "I consent to the LTA and/or the organisers of LTA tournaments, from my geographical area, using the details provided on the entry form to communicate information about this and future tournaments, in my geographical area, via post/email or SMS."
